Rd west for 13 miles. When it enters Rush Co. it is a gravel road. Continue to the first crossroad, CR 390, turn left (south), go 1/2 mile to our mailbox on the Right, turning right on our driveway. 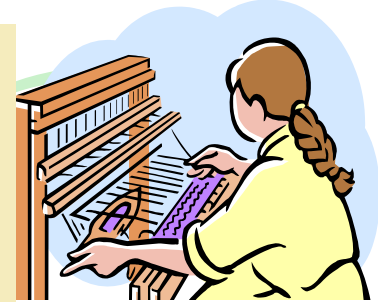
