I hope you are all enjoying a wonderful summer!! We have officially completed another academic school year and soon will be starting another! Here are some of the highlights from the last year:

- The DLC accepted 356 new learners last year. We maintained many older matches and finished the year with 358 active learners.
- We gained 21 new GED tutors and 92 new ESL tutors. We currently have 213 tutors volunteering their time with us.
- We had 8 learners earn their GED and another 7 take and pass at least one of the 4 required tests for their GED.
- We helped 35 learners create a GED account in preparation for their eventual test.
- We gave out over 50 books as learners advanced in either ESL, Language Arts, or Math.

In other DLC news:

Sr. Nancy taught an ESL class at St. Mary Magdalene for the 2021-2022 school year. She was knowledgeable in her field as well as kind and generous with her gifts. Sr. Nancy passed away two days ago and will truly be missed. May she rest in peace.

- 3. Culture Forums: In an effort to better understand the community with which we are working, the DLC is going to





The Social Studies has already begun, but the Science classes will be offered beginning this month. - **6. New Parish Site:** You may know that we offer ESL classes at several parish sites throughout Columbus. I am excited to announce that this year we will be opening a new site at St. Matthias. We have had a lot of support from Fr. Tony and the parish council there, so I am thrilled to extend our relationship with them in this way.


Learner Success Stories:
